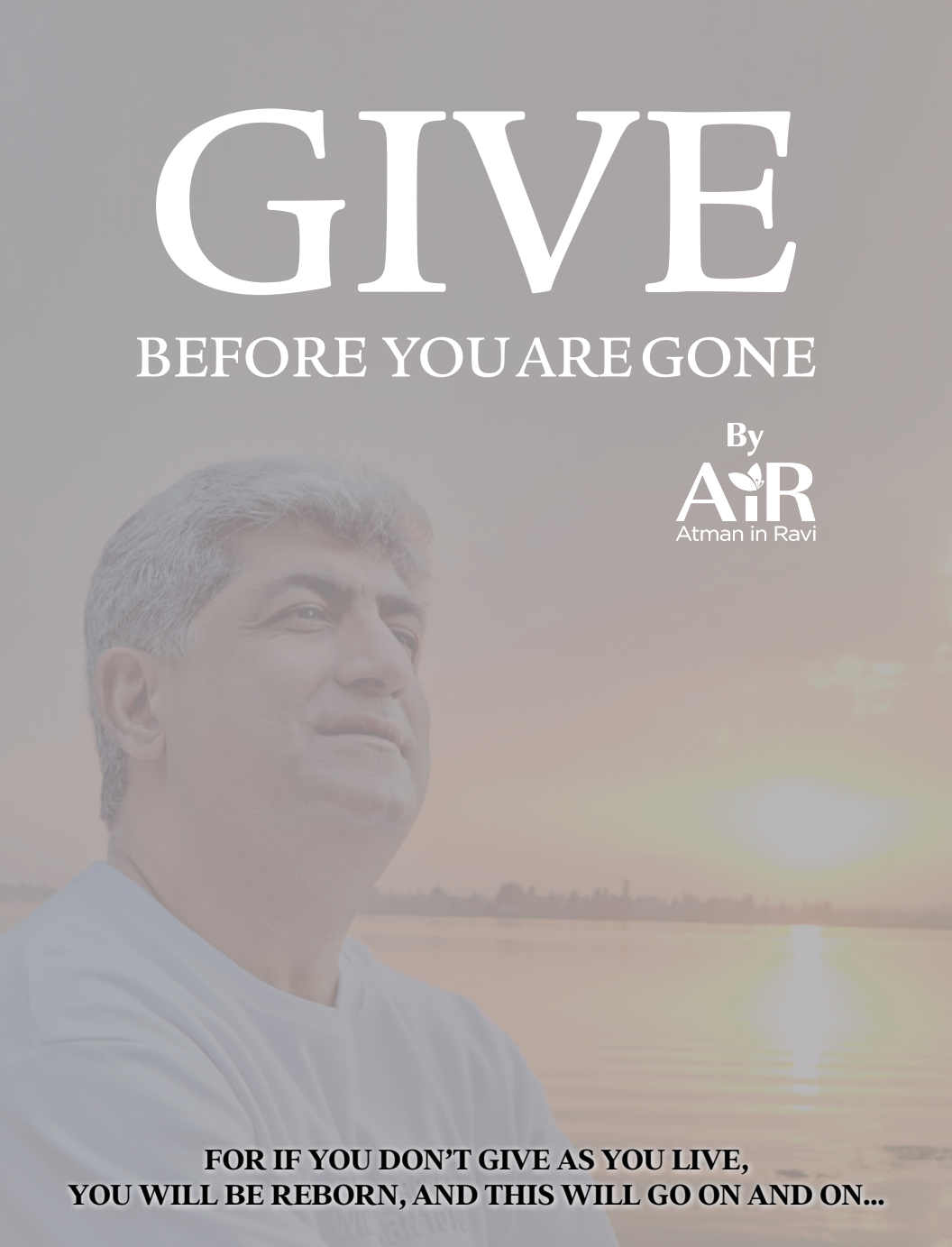

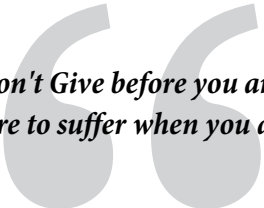

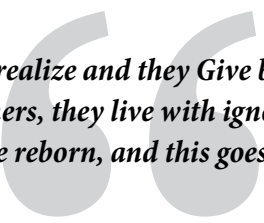

I realized this very early in life and I have been giving for nearly 40 years. I live as the happiest man in the world because I give every day that I live. Every act of giving creates happiness that cannot be measured in currency notes and coins. My giving not only gave me happiness but gave me so much success and wealth that I never found myself in a situation where I did not have enough to give. I gave freely and wholeheartedly, creating joy. What did I realize? My coffers were never empty. Every time I gave, my bins got filled with far more than what I gave. Such is the magical law of *Karma*. The more you give, the more you will get. And it is not just about money and wealth, it is more to do with joy and happiness. When we make others happy, our life becomes full of happiness. When we put a smile on somebody's face, our life becomes full of smiles and laughter. ANDREW CARNEGIE

Andrew Carnegie came from Scotland to the United States and started work at age thirteen. He eventually launched the steel industry in Pittsburgh. At age sixty-five, he sold the company to J. P. Morgan for \$480 million and devoted the rest of his life to his philanthropic activities and writing. During his lifetime, Carnegie gave away over \$350 million. He was perhaps the first to state publicly that the rich have a moral obligation to give away their fortunes. He wrote 'The Gospel of Wealth', in which he states that all personal wealth beyond what is required for the needs of one's family should be regarded as a trust fund for the benefit of the community. His philanthropic interests focused on education, world peace and the establishment of free public libraries. He built 2,509 libraries throughout the English-speaking world.

JOHN D. ROCKEFELLER

John D. Rockefeller is considered to be the wealthiest man and the most prominent philanthropist in the history of United States. He made his millions through the American oil industry. Rockefeller donated more than 500 million dollars to religious, educational, and scientific causes through his Foundation. He funded the establishment of the University of Chicago and the Rockefeller Institute, among many other philanthropic endeavours.

BILL GATES

Bill Gates, the founder of Microsoft along with his ex-wife, Melinda Gates are well known for their charitable donations. Estimated to be worth over \$130 billion, Gates has given away over \$50 billion over the years to various non-profit organizations and causes that he is passionate about. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation's vision is to 'Improve the quality of life for individuals around the world.' As two of the world's biggest philanthropists, they have found a way to make the world a better place through their common goal of giving back.

WARREN BUFFETT

Warren Buffett has given more than \$46 billion to charity and is known as one of the world's biggest philanthropists. Buffett is believed to be on the top of the list of the 10 richest people in the world. Along with his generosity as a philanthropist, Buffett is also known for his commitment to living modestly, his humility and his strong values lead to an extraordinary life.

She is also considered as one of the world's high-impact philanthropists. From books, movies, theme parks, and merchandise sales, Rowling quickly rose to billionaire status. She supports child welfare programs by advocating for and funding various education, health and social care system reforms.

OPRAH WINFREY

Oprah Winfrey, who grew up in a poor household enduring sexual abuse, still managed to overcome the many obstacles she faced and found major success. She has donated millions of dollars through the Oprah Winfrey Charitable Foundation including contributing more than \$140 million to The Oprah Winfrey Leadership Academy for Girls.

MICHAEL JORDAN

He has made multimillion-dollar donations to Friends of the

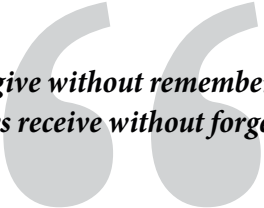

The one who was alive in the body, the mind and ego, ME, returns to earth in a rebirth, carrying its *Karma*. The cycle goes on and on. We die and we are reborn. Nobody can escape the

cycle of birth and death. While we cannot control what is unfolding in our life, because it is based on our past actions, our past *Karma*, we can surely control our present actions, our present *Karma*, and thereby take charge of our future, our destiny. If we Give before we are Gone, and we serve people on the street, helping them get back on their feet, there is no doubt that our good *Karma*, will create good circumstances in our life that will unfold. 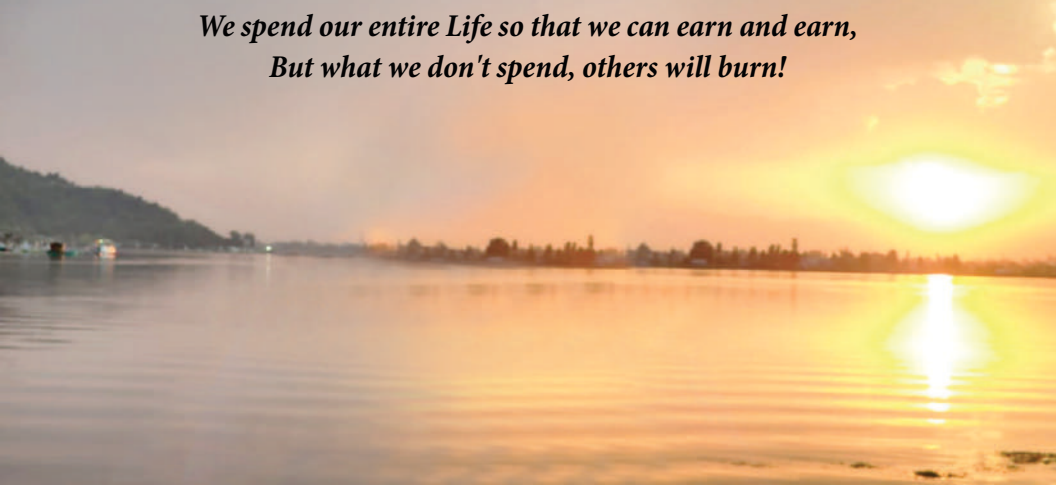

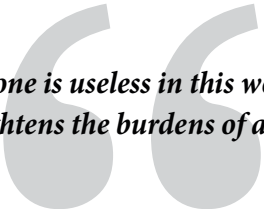
Most people will be surprised, even shocked to read this. But

Very few! We know that about 1% of this world is visually blind, but we don't know that 99% of the world is spiritually blind. We don't realize that we are the Divine Spirit, the Immortal Soul or *Atman*, that leaves the body at death.

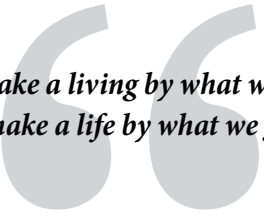

Why don't People Give?

It is strange to see people becoming richer and richer, only to ultimately die, taking nothing with them. Is it because people don't know that they will die? Is it because they think they can carry their wealth beyond death? Is it because they don't experience joy in giving? What causes people to earn and earn and ultimately, they burn, and everything they own is lost in a flash!

This fear of becoming poor paralyzes people when it comes to giving. Although they have a lot, fear stops them. What is fear? F E A R means a False Expectation Appearing Real. It is only a trick of their imagination, but their fear appears to be real and so, they are paranoid and paralyzed. They have so much that even if they give a little of what they have, it will make no difference. But *Fear makes the wolf seem bigger than it is*. It makes them insecure and they fear living on the street.

Haven't you heard of many a story where parents give away everything to their children, only to find themselves homeless, penniless, struggling to survive? They end up in a destitute home with tears. Is it necessary to give away everything that you have and end up being a beggar? This is another extreme in giving, where you are careless and reckless. One must refrain from reaching such a position, but just because there have been others, who have foolishly managed their wealth, it does not mean that one should not Give before they are Gone.

No doubt money is an important factor, and one must control their money efficiently in their lifetime. But just as we must control our money while we live, we must also manage it so that it is distributed in the right way, at our death. Otherwise, if we don't give, and we are gone, then, everything will be wasted. These are two extremes we see and both extremes must be avoided because in one extreme, we lose everything and in the second extreme, we waste everything. Neither should we lose or waste, we should use our resources effectively so that there is fulfilment at the end of the journey.

Just imagine you have tons of money, gems, jewels, valuables and properties, and you are confused about who to give it to before you die. You are also insecure, and you fear being left on the street with all your wealth snatched away from you. And so, you don't give away anything. Your insecurity makes you cling to everything and then you die! Whether you like it or not, your near and dear ones will snatch away what was yours. And what you did not use, you finally had to lose, because you did not Give before you were Gone.

Many wealthy, elderly people have a huge insecurity syndrome. They have seen several elderly parents cry because their children cheated them and snatched away everything. Because they are insecure, they are not willing to give a penny. Little do they realize that ultimately, nothing will belong to them.

Those who don't use their money and are forced to lose it at death, have wasted their life, just as those who carelessly gave up everything, live with regret as they struggle after they

have given everything away. Our challenge is to find a path that can help us Give before we are Gone, without having to face the situation of becoming a beggar. There are ways where we can protect ourselves and ensure that our wealth is distributed when we are in good health, rather than have people fight for our assets when we are in the coffin.

Whatever be the reason, not giving away our wealth before we die is the worst option. We may assign our wealth and property to deserving people but leaving it behind only means that it will reach the hands of those who do not deserve it. We must remember that nothing is ours because we brought nothing with us, and we can take nothing when we go. Such is the show! When we do not Give before we Go, it means that we wasted an opportunity, whatever be the reason.

We must learn the art of surrender. After all, everything unfolds as per a Divine will and as per our past actions, our *Karma*. We can't change our past *Karma*. They are already done, but we can choose our present *Karma*. Having done that, the next thing we need to do is to surrender and accept the Divine will. We have no choice. Whatever is unfolding will unfold. Nothing can stop it. But we have a free will. We can use our intellect to discriminate, but thereafter, we are helpless. We must surrender. We have no option. Sometimes, it looks like bad things happen to good people. This is not possible as per the Law of *Karma*. Therefore, we have no choice but to surrender and let go. Giving is also an act of surrender. Once we give, we trust the Divine and we surrender

our life to the Divine. We don't live with fear, with worry. We believe that the Divine is in control of everything. For the Divine, nothing is impossible. Nothing happens against the will of the Divine. We may wonder whether the Divine interferes with *Karma*. What we don't realize is that even the Law of *Karma* is controlled by SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power. When we give with complete faith and trust, we surrender to the Divine just like a sailboat that trusts the waters of the ocean. Of course, we have already discussed that we should use our intelligence while giving, but once we give, there is no looking back. We must protect our life and live, but when the time comes to go, we should have given everything away. This is to have truly lived a meaningful life.

Those who don't believe in the Power of the Divine, those who do not live with FAITH – Full Assurance In The Heart, HOPE, Having Only Positive Expectations, TRUST– Total Reliance Unconditional Surrender to The Almighty, such people cannot give. Such people live with doubt, despair, and pessimism. They do not even trust in SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power. They believe in ghosts and devils, and mythological fairy tales. When it is time to go, at the end of the show, they have tons of money, property and wealth that is wasted because they did not trust and did not give before they moved on.

Unfortunately, we submit to the mind and its thoughts. The mind constantly produces negative thoughts, creating fear, stress, worry, anxiety, and depression. These negative thoughts become the toxic energy that stops us from the act of

philanthropy. The negative thoughts steal our compassion and kindness and make us live with insecurity. Ultimately, toxic thoughts become toxic feelings and toxic actions. That is why we end up with a toxic destiny. We may have millions when it comes to money in the bank. But when it comes to kindness, compassion and charity, we are no better than the bankrupt beggars. Our life has not only been wasted but the opportunity to achieve the ultimate purpose of life is lost.

Remember, there is joy in giving and when we do not give, we deprive ourselves of the joy. When we go, nothing will be ours anyway. But when we give, we experience deep happiness. Whatever we do not give, will not go with us and we have no doubt about this. Then what sense is it to live without giving, and die with so much wealth, which is uselessly left behind? When will the world wake up to realize this deep act of foolish ignorance? It is time for the world to wake up and to Give before they are Gone. It is time for the spiritually blind to remove their spiritual cataract. It is time for the world to realize that giving is not an option!

But suppose the same transaction happened when you were awake. I came to you and borrowed a large sum of money. You would document it and take my signature on the printed agreement. Therefore, we consider a dream to be just a dream, but life to be real. Those who realize the truth, realize that life too is nothing

more than a dream. The only difference is that the dream gets over when we get up in the morning. Life gets over at death. But ultimately, life too is nothing more than a dream.

What is an illusion? It is something that appears to be but is not. We are familiar with a mirage in the desert. There appears to be an oasis far away, but in reality, there is no oasis. It is just a mirage. It is common to experience seeing a large patch of water while driving on a road in summer. We imagine that there is water ahead, but as we drive to that point, the water disappears. It was not there at all. It was just an illusion, an appearance. While we are quite familiar with illusions of the world, we don't contemplate and learn from the illusion that this world itself is *Maya*, a huge Cosmic Illusion. We understand that the rainbow may appear to be a beautiful band of the seven colours of VIBGYOR, but can we hug the rainbow? It appears to be there. We can even take a photograph, but we can't catch a rainbow. It is just an appearance.

Seekers of the Spiritual truth understand the concept of *Maya* or Cosmic Illusion. They realize that this world or *Jagat* is *Mithya*, unreal, temporary, transitory. They contemplate a gold ring. 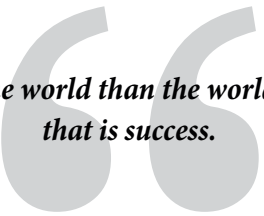

There is great joy in giving and when we give to those in need, that is the best deed. There are people who do not have enough food to eat. They sometimes live with just one meal a day. There are people who don't have enough clothes, while there are others who have no shelter over their heads. Of course, we will receive joy in giving, but every giving is like planting a seed that will bear fruit. Unfortunately, there are many people, the wealthiest of the wealthiest, who never

THE LAW OF KARMA

*Karma is a Universal Law of this earth,

What is *Karma*? By itself, the word *Karma* means action. But today, *Karma* has become globally known as the Law of Action and Reaction. Some people call it the law of the boomerang because they believe that what goes around, comes around. Others link it to the scripture which states, '*As you sow, so shall you reap.*' The Law of *Karma* is very simple. It is a Universal Law, and it appears in many aspects of our life. The seeds we plant, decide the fruits on the tree. So also, the deeds that we plant will decide our destiny. While we are absolutely sure about the seed and the fruit, as we are able to observe the root and the shoot, we are unable to see how *Karma* works and sometimes get carried away and question the existence of such a law.

This world is governed by certain Universal Laws. We do not question the existence of the Law of Gravity. That is why if we throw a ball up in the sky, it does not fly away but returns to earth. While we can see this phenomenon, we don't question what the cause of our birth was. Our birth is controlled by the Law of *Karma*, the law that brings us back to earth. Do you doubt that the sun will rise tomorrow morning? You do not doubt it because the Law of Cycles makes the earth rotate exactly once in 24 hours, causing day and night. The same Universal Law creates seasons in cycles as the earth revolves around the sun. While we don't doubt the Law of Cycles, some of us doubt the Law of *Karma*. Sadly, we question and ask, 'Why do bad things happen to good people?' We don't realize that as per the Universal Law of *Karma*, bad things can't happen to good people, just as apples can't grow on mango trees. It is not possible for the earth to stop rotating. It

is this rotation that causes day and night, or to stop revolving and have no seasons. Imagine, tomorrow our tables and chairs start flying with us in the sky, because there is no Law of Gravity. ‘Impossible!’ you would say because, without the Universal Law, this world cannot be governed.

The Creator, whom we refer to as SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power, has instituted several laws and we cannot escape from these laws. One such law is that of birth and death. Every living creature must die. Do we deny the existence of this law? While we know it and accept it, we do not question and realize, ‘Where do we come from and where will we go?’ What is the cause of our birth on earth? We do not ponder on the fact that the body comes later. We are conceived first, 9 months before our birthday. One day, the body will die, and people will say that we passed away. Then, our loved ones will destroy the body, the one who always said, it was ‘I’. All this is connected with the Law of *Karma*. But because we do not understand the reality, we don’t go on a quest and realize the truth, we live and die with the myth. We don’t Give before we are Gone, and our ignorance ensures that we are reborn, and this goes on and on.

We must understand the Law of *Karma* first, then see how to use it effectively for our happiness and wellbeing, and finally how to transcend *Karma* to be liberated from all the suffering on earth, the triple suffering of the body, mind and ego and finally liberated from the cycle of death and rebirth. Who does *Karma*? It appears that the body does *Karma*. But in reality, the body is just an instrument that acts. The one who does the

Karma is ME, the Mind and Ego. Without the Director, ME, the actor, the body, would not act. Therefore, the *Karma* does not belong to the body, even though it seems that it is the body that is doing the action, and experiencing the consequences of *Karma*, be it pleasure or pain. Little do we realize that without the mind and ego, the body cannot even experience pleasure and pain. The feeling of pleasure and pain is experienced by not just the gross physical body, but by the subtle body that is our operating system. Just like a computer, the human-computer too has hardware or the body-complex and software or the mind-complex. However, just like a computer cannot work without a power supply, the human body too cannot function with the body and mind, its hardware and software. It needs a power supply. The power supply is the Soul. The moment the power departs, we experience death, there is no breath, and there is no more *Karma*. The body cannot perform any action, just as the Mind and Ego, ME has no power to direct any further action.

But what happens at death? Don't we know that the body dies and it is cremated or buried? Therefore, the gross aspect of us disappears into ashes. What about all the *Karma* that it did? The pending actions are like seeds that were planted but did not sprout. Those who understand *Karma*, the law, realize that the deeds that we have done do not disappear. The body dies, but the Mind and Ego, ME, carries its pending *Karma* and is reborn in a new body. This happens when the Power of the Soul departs at death but returns at that point of conception where the ME, the Mind and Ego is reborn in a new body, to start a new journey, to settle all old *Karma*.

Many people are confused about what this Power is. This Power which we call Soul or Spirit, *Atman* or *Ruh*, *Chi* or *Prana*, is the very life force that is the essence of our existence. Without this power, there could be no birth, no life, and no rebirth. Whatever *Karma* we do, is empowered by the Soul. The Soul does not own the *Karma*. It is just a Power that comes and goes. The Power in you and me, is the same Power. This can be easily understood when we compare it to the electricity in our house. We might have a white bulb and a yellow bulb, a television and a refrigerator. These are different gadgets, but the Power that makes them turn on is the same single source of Power. Unfortunately, we human beings do not understand this truth. We need to realize it. Somehow, we believe, as we were taught, that 'my Soul is different from your Soul'. This is the root cause of our ignorance. It causes us to believe that we are the body and mind. It makes us perform actions and create *Karma* and this *Karma* makes us return to the earth in a rebirth, again and again. Most of us are intelligent to understand that once the body dies and is returned to dust, where is the question of going to heaven or hell. This is a fairy tale that our scriptures tell. Whatever we do, good or bad, we experience the result of it in a heaven or a hell, right here on earth when we take rebirth. That is why a child is born blind. That is why somebody else is born in the lap of luxury. The Universal Law of *Karma* makes no mistake. It returns good for good and evil for evil and this cycle goes on and on. Nobody can escape from the cycle, except the one who realizes that we are not the body that does *Karma*, not the mind and ego that directs all action. We are the Divine Soul. A very rare minority is able to realize this truth. This small group of people is

liberated from *Karma*, just as these people are liberated from the cycle of death and rebirth. The rest of us, just live and die because we never ask the question, 'Who am I?' We just create *Karma*, and we experience life on earth as a human being. We never realize we are manifestations of the Divine. We are part of SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power, that most of us call 'God'. Because we do not realize this, we live and we die, and we do not experience that state of Eternal Happiness, Divine Love and Everlasting Peace. Those of us who realize, are free from this cycle. We are liberated from returning to earth and we are united with the Divine. This is our ultimate goal – to realize we are the Divine Soul.

But what has all this got to do with giving? Why should we Give before we are Gone? The connection is easy and simple. Those who don't give, but live, without realizing the truth of *Karma*, may seem to enjoy pleasures on earth. However, they cannot escape from *Karma*. The first category of people, ignore the Law of *Karma* completely. They live selfish lives, without caring, sharing and giving. For sure, they will suffer, because they do everything wrong to earn and to enjoy the pleasures of this world. Why? Because they did not learn about *Karma*. They did not understand the simple law that is based on cause and effect. Whatever you do, it has to come back to you. If we perform evil deeds, we have to pay for the evil we did. Such is the law! Those who understand the law and choose to be philanthropic, they give and give, knowing that giving is not a waste. Every act of charity, of help, of sharing, is a seed they plant. It will return as a fortune or good destiny in their present life journey on earth. Not just that, if

their acts of charity are not rewarded in this life, the Law of *Karma* will ensure that they will be rewarded in their next life. Those who wonder how this can be possible, must introspect on how a child is born in a palace. What was the reason? Why is another child born in a slum? This is not luck or chance. This is the Law of *Karma* unfolding.

Therefore, those who give as they live, are creating good *Karma*. They may give food to abandoned children, or they may give clothes to a blind school. It hardly matters to whom you give and what you give, as long as the attitude of giving is sincere. Those who understand the Law of *Karma* and give as they live are sure to be rewarded for their good deeds. So also, those who don't give, but just live and die, collecting wealth, soon lose their health and when they die, they have no investments in their *Karmic* account that will bear return in their new life. They are sure to suffer because they ignored the law of *Karma*. Therefore, understanding the law, and giving while living is a very important aspect of life.

Unfortunately, most of us don't realize that as long as we create *Karma*, good or bad, we have to return to earth. There is no escape. Those who return to earth, get caught in this world or *Samsara*. The mind and ego is reborn in a new body and cannot escape *Dukkha*. What is this triple suffering that every human being experiences on earth? It is suffering caused by the pain of the body, the suffering caused by the misery of the mind, and the suffering caused by the agony of the ego. All of us experience this triple suffering the moment we return to earth in a rebirth. Is that the reason, some people wonder, that a

little child that is born, screams and cries at birth, already aware that it has to face the triple suffering? Otherwise, it might have arrived, laughing and giggling out of the mother's womb.

What then must we do about *Karma*? First of all, we must become aware of the law. Did we not learn, 'ignorance of Law is no excuse'? Just because we did not know that such a law exists, we cannot escape it. Our first challenge is to earn good *Karma*, to be kind and generous, loving and caring. Every act of our life must be a good deed. This will become a good seed that will germinate and sprout into happiness. We must desist from bad deeds because they will become bad *Karma* that will sprout as our suffering. This is the first simple learning about *Karma*. We must learn to give. The more we give, the more good *Karma* we create. We must give as much as we can, to as many as we can, as often as we can. This is what I learned from my Guru, my Spiritual Mentor, Dada J.P. Vaswani. So, I give every day that I live, and I urge you to give too. If we understand *Karma* and do this much, at least, we will not suffer on the planet in this lifetime. Giving becomes an insurance premium we pay, the result of which will also come in our next life.

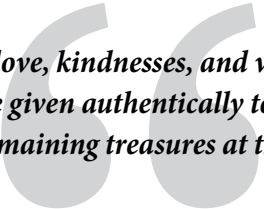
Before we close on *Karma*, we must understand that *Karma* has 3 accounts. One account is our corpus, something like a warehouse or fixed deposit. Every life that we end, the net balance of good and bad *Karma*, gets added to this continuous corpus of *Karma*. It is known as *Sanchita Karma*. Every time, we start a new life, we pick the opening balance of our *Karma* from this corpus. If the corpus has a lot of good *Karma*, we can have a

good life. If the corpus has only bad *Karma*, we cannot have a good life. The opening balance is known as *Prarabdha Karma*. Does it mean that if our opening balance is bad, full of negative *Karma*, we are doomed to live and die a miserable life? No! *Karma* gives us another opportunity. We have free will. Only human beings can choose as they are blessed with an intellect. We can create good *Karma* and bad *Karma*, through our choices that become actions or deeds. This *Agami Karma* can not only wipe out the *Prarabdha Karma* or the opening balance, but if we seek the truth, are blessed with the guidance of a Spiritual Master, and we yearn for the Divine, we may be enlightened and drop all our *Karma*, not just the opening balance, but even the corpus that we have been carrying forward, life after life. The moment we realize we are not the body that does *Karma*, not the ME, Mind and Ego that carries *Karma* life after life, we are the Divine Soul, in that moment, we are liberated from all our *Karma*, just as we are liberated from *Samsara*, the cycle of death and rebirth.

Such a realized Soul, known as a *Jivanmukta*, lives as a *Stithpragya*, with a steady intellect, till the destined moment when the body dies. Having realized that he is not the body, mind and ego, he is the Divine Soul, he is liberated from coming to earth and eternally united with the Divine. This is a state known as *Moksha* or *Nirvana* and it happens when we transcend all our *Karma*.

The first step to be liberated from *Samsara*, to attain a state of *Moksha*, or *Nirvana*, is to give. We must make giving a habit. First, we must create good *Karma*, and secure a life devoid of

suffering. But this is not enough. The next step is to attain that state of Self-Realization, where we realize we are not the body, the mind, the ego but we are the Divine Soul. This will liberate us from rebirth and unite us with the Divine.

The journey of life is to discover who we truly are. If we live and we die, and we don't realize, 'Who am I?' then we will suffer and cry, look at the sky and ask, 'Why?' and then just die! Why did we come to earth? Why were we not a dog or a frog? Why were we not bound to the ground like a tree that was not free? Why have we been given eyes to see and an amazing body to be who we are meant to be? Why are we the only species who has a free will and still remains in ignorance and does not discover who we are and why we are here? We chase success because we were taught that success is happiness. We don't realize that the reverse is true – Happiness is Success. To be happy, we keep climbing the peak of achievement and we make money. Our need becomes our greed, and we want more and more, till finally, our coffin goes out of the door. Life is over! Have we realized what life is all about?

Not many people understand the meaning of Self-Realization, although the term is flippantly used. Realization is not knowledge. Many people may have knowledge about living and giving, but Realization is not just knowledge. It is experiencing the Consciousness of truth. It is only when our knowledge crystalizes that we can open our real eyes to realize the truth. What is this Self-Realization all about? It is realizing that we are not you and me. We are all one Power, one Energy. This earth is a stage. Everything is a show. We are actors who come and go. Therefore, whatever we get, we must give as we live.

The one who wants Self-Realization goes on a quest with unanswered questions. He wants the truth. He wants to overcome the myth and so, he is persistent. He takes with him

If they cremate my body and say that I passed away, then who is the one who I truly am, who passed away? Clearly, I am not the body. Who am I? If I think I am the mind and I try to find the mind, where is the mind, I cannot find. Then, I questioned if there was something like *Karma*. Did it really exist, and would I be reborn, reincarnated as per my *Karma*? Does God control all this? Who is God, where is God, and what is God? Has God created Souls that are invisible? Are there good Souls and bad Souls? What is Enlightenment, Salvation, *Nirvana*, *Moksha* that religions talk about? I had these and many more questions as I started my journey of Self-Realization, my quest to realize the truth.

To succeed in the quest, we have to follow the 3-step method - Ask, Investigate and Realize the truth. I did not blindly believe what I read and what I heard. Even science endorses that the 30 trillion cells of the human body are ultimately, nothing but energy.

I further realized that God was not God. God was not he or she. God is a Power in you and me. God is SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power. The names and forms we give God are a pack of lies. I realized many more things, that we human beings live and die in ignorance, that our ignorance makes us believe that we are the Mind and Ego, ME. 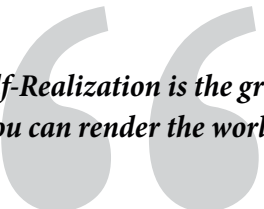

Who are you Giving to?

Some people feel that there is no big deal in giving. They are giving every day. They are giving their customers service and products. They are giving their employees salaries and perks and they are providing everything for their family and their near and dear ones. Is this giving? This is not giving. This is just a transaction. You have no choice. You have to give your customers because they pay you for it. You have to remunerate your staff, for the services they provide. You are also obliged to provide for your family and your near and dear ones, just as you expect them to fulfil your expectations. This is called '*Quid pro quo*' – this for that. When we exchange this for that, it is not giving. True giving is giving without having any expectations.

Most people think that they give, but in reality, they only give to live. Otherwise, if they had a choice, they would not give. They like to store, to hoard, to collect as much as they can, without realizing that ultimately, nothing is theirs and will be theirs. The ones who really give do not give when they are compelled to, but rather constantly share what they have with others who are in need. They are the ones who are truly giving. This giving is not a transaction. It is an offering to the Divine who manifests in the poor, the discarded, the destitute and the downtrodden.

Some people give only to those whom they love. Is this giving? This is not giving because it is expecting love in return! Giving is truly giving when we expect nothing in return. Suppose you give away walking sticks in a blind school, you expect nothing. This is giving! Of course, some people give because they expect a good *Karma* in return. This

is permitted. Giving for the sake of doing good *Karma*, is the only expectation that is permitted in giving. There should be no other expectation. We must give selflessly, without any selfish motive. Giving cannot be a manipulation. Some people give just because they get tax benefits. Is this giving? By now we are clear what giving is all about.

Many decades ago, an Indian Saint – Vivekananda stated that 'service to humanity is prayer to God'. What did he mean? He meant that man in reality is not the body that he appears to be. Man is a manifestation of the Divine. When we serve man as a Divine manifestation, this is the best way to pray to God. Vivekananda realized that God is not somewhere far away in the stars. God is the very Soul in every living creature. Therefore, when we reach out with love and compassion, and we serve man or beast, we are actually serving our Lord. 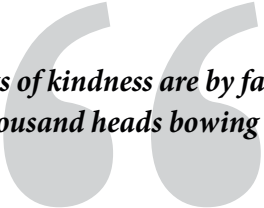
Who are you Giving to?

FROM KARMA TO MOKSHA

Giving is not a simple act of sharing what we have. Giving is a very profound way of expressing both our *Dharma* and our understanding of *Karma*.

What is the connection between giving and *Dharma*? *Dharma* is a word which is not clearly defined because of the way it is interpreted and understood. To some, it is like a cosmic law that defines the way we should live in a society with righteousness. *Dharma* to others is a collection of religious and moral duties that govern our conduct and philosophy of life. From *Dharma*, one picks up the Universal Law of *Karma* and tries to live with good action. This choice is based both on *Dharma*, our moral responsibility to give, help and serve, just as it is connected to *Karma*, the Law that states that whatever we give, is what we will get. When it comes to *Dharma*, we are taught, right from the beginning, that the world is one family, and we must share our fortunes with others. We must be compassionate and kind to those who are less fortunate than us. This is *Dharma*. Even a poor man who has one pound of bread, should share some of it with a hungry person on the street as per *Dharma*. Therefore, giving is intrinsically a part of human *Dharma* or basic essential philosophy of life. No religion, no culture, no civilization exists which does not encourage the *Dharma* of giving. In fact, it is embedded in most scriptures of this world. Not everybody understands the logic that giving has a deeper meaning, but people give anyway because of the feel-good factor that comes with giving. There are some who give because of society. 'What would people say, if I don't give? I would be going against my *Dharma*, my basic moral obligation towards the suffering and downtrodden'.

While giving is closely connected to *Dharma*, it is subconsciously rooted with *Karma*, the law. 'The more we give, the more we will get', is the inspiration that motivates the world towards charity and philanthropy. Haven't we heard of people saying that after we are rich and successful, it is time to give back to society? Why? Because it is in giving that we receive. Such is the Universal Law of *Karma*. People clearly understand the Law of the boomerang – what goes around, comes around. Goodness, kindness that leaves us is never wasted and only returns to us multi-fold. Those who live with the philosophy of *Karma*, try to do good *Karma* so that their destiny can be filled with good fortune and happiness.

Giving, however, has a far more profound meaning for the one who is seeking the true purpose of life. The person gives because of *Dharma*, and also because of *Karma*. But it is *Moksha*, that makes one give away everything before they are gone. When one realizes that they are not the body, mind and ego, but the Divine Soul, and it is so obvious that nothing belongs to us, then they do not collect and hoard possessions that do not belong to them. They give as they live because they realize, 'Who am I?' They understand that this body is going to die. Whatever they get, they give. They only retain what they need to survive. This is a mark of an enlightened person. The way a person gives as he lives shows how much he has realized life and its purpose. Not only does the person not do bad *Karma*, as he realizes the Divine in one and all, but he also gives away without having any expectations. Expectations create desires that bind us to *Karma* and make us

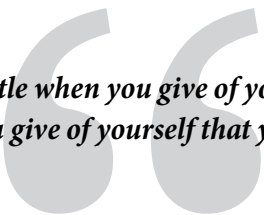
return to earth. This is not what a realized one seeks. The realized one has understood the purpose of life. It is to go beyond the basic moral duties of *Dharma*, it is not to get caught in *Artha* or wealth, not to be trapped in *Kama* or lust, but to ultimately obtain *Moksha* or liberation. These four, *Dharma*, *Artha*, *Kama* and *Moksha* are known as the *Purushartha*, the purpose of life in 4 stages. The ultimate destination is *Moksha* or liberation, not to return to earth in a rebirth.

The giver who gives with an attitude of *Karma*, is planting seeds through his deeds. He has to return to earth. However, the giver who gives, with the goal of *Moksha*, has no expectations. He not only gives, and forgives, but also forgets what he gives, so there is no thought of getting fruit of his actions. Such a person is a *KarmaYogi*, one who lives as an instrument of the Divine, one who is free from *Dharma*, *Artha* and *Kama* – duty, wealth and lust and who only aspires for *Moksha*, liberation from this world and unification with the Divine.

Therefore, it is in giving as a *Karma Yogi* that one attains the true purpose of life, known to the world as *Moksha* or *Nirvana*, Liberation or Salvation. It is not only freedom from ignorance and freedom from the triple suffering of the body, mind and ego, it is also Liberation from rebirth and not returning to earth.

Give, before you are gone, for this opens the door that takes you through *Karma*, to *Moksha*, the ultimate goal of Liberation from this world and unification with the Divine. Giving not

only gives peace and joy while we are alive but leads us to eternal happiness and everlasting peace through Realization and Liberation. After all, it is a simple truth that nothing belongs to us, not even our body. Due to ignorance, we don't give as we live. At first, we give because we want to do good *Karma* and we want a better destiny. But thereafter, we give as a *Karma Yogi*. We give because we realize that nothing is ours, that when we go, we can take nothing with us. Therefore, we give as a *Karma Yogi* and this realization leads us to the ultimate goal of *Moksha*.

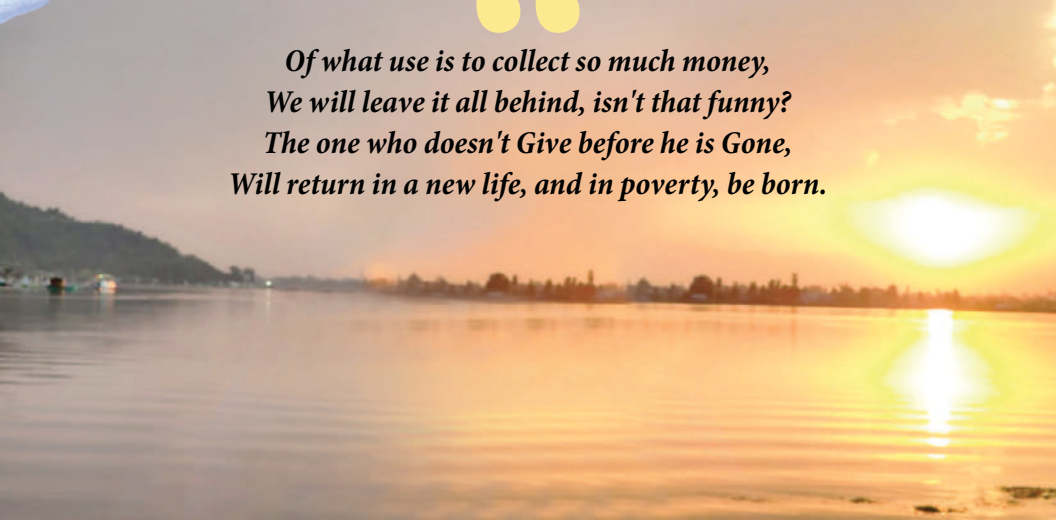

were rich, they die poor, because they cannot take a penny with them.

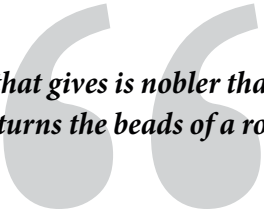

MY 'GIVING' JOURNEY

*I had nothing, but whatever I got,

No doubt the world saw me as a successful person because whatever I touched turned to gold. There was success and more success. But the world did not understand the secret of my success. To me, the secret was simple – it was based on the universal law of *Karma* – *As you sow, so shall you reap. What you give is what you will get.*

From my first success, whatever I made, I gave a lot of it away. Somehow, I did not have the habit of being selfish, hoarding and storing my wealth. I don't even know why I gave, because it started when I was a child. Today, I feel grateful that I was blessed to give, for I realize that it is in giving that we receive. One thing is sure, my success was fuelled by my giving. The deeds of charity and service undoubtedly became the seeds that created the roots of success, the shoots of prosperity and the fruits of wealth and happiness.

I gave to everybody I could, not just my family and friends. But to strangers as well. I would give my love to old people, who needed help to cross the street. I would share my meals, with those who worked in our household. When I started earning, I shared my income with the poor and the underprivileged who were sleeping on the streets. What I am sharing is not some theory. It is my personal experience that the more I gave, the more I received. In fact, I received much more than what I gave away.

My giving continued as my success hit the skies. I made millions, but I also gave away millions. It had become an automatic circle of my life. I experienced great joy in giving

and this inspired me to give more and more.

From my initial business success, I set up a humanitarian trust. Our goal was to pick up people from the street and put them back on their feet. Some people had not eaten for days. They would have died. It was through Divine intervention that the team in our Trust, which was full of people with compassion and humanitarian hearts, was led to serve the destitute and the downtrodden. We found beggars on the street, and we set up small shops for them and provided them with merchandise to sell so that they did not have to beg for a living. When houses were ravaged by rains, we would reconstruct the roofs of the houses of the poor. We did anything and everything possible to serve the needy.

I was barely 30 when I started a weekly 'Giving day'. Every Monday, I would sit and wait for people to come to me with their problems and their needs. I would personally listen to their stories and try to find a way to help them. We helped thousands of people live with dignity and respect. We gave medicines to the poor, just as we funded their surgeries and treatment.

As we did this, we realized that the existing charitable homes had limitations. They had too many conditions for admission and did not admit all those who needed support. We found a child who was both mentally and physically challenged. Since we supported and sponsored several charitable institutions, we approached them for admission. One said that they could only take care of the physically challenged,

while another institution stated that they could take care of only those who were mentally challenged. We were left helpless and hopeless.

We decided to set up our own humanitarian home. We bought a piece of land and constructed a 100-bed home. We had a few cases that could not find admission in any charitable institution. A poor maid servant had a child, and she approached a charitable mission. They refused to accept the child, until she promised never to see the child again. Sobbing and crying, she brought the child to us. Hundreds of such cases, of people who are turned away at charitable homes, still come to us. We admit them in one of our 3 charitable homes. We have about 700 people staying with us. We look after them, providing food, clothing, medicines and love and care. They are our family!

Where did the money come from? I don't even know. All I know, is that when we wanted the money, it was always there. There was never a time when we were short of funds. Even today, we spend millions to serve the poor, and while there are several supporters and donors who contribute to this mammoth but humble effort, it was 'giving', for sure, that led to us receiving the funds and the support we needed to make all this possible. While I gave a lot to the destitute, I also wanted to do something for God. At that time, I was deeply religious, and my faith in my God made me build a 65-foot statue of my Lord. Little did I realize that trying to give for my God's temple would become another source of getting resources to do bigger charitable projects.

The 'Giving' journey has never stopped. I have evolved from a religious to a spiritual person, and my transformation has led to my metamorphosis. I continue to lead the charitable and other organizations that I have set up. But personally what I now give to others are my Realizations. I give away books, just as I give away a lot of innovative merchandise that can help people realize the truth about life. While I can't 'give' Enlightenment to others, I give talks and provide answers to questions that can help people on the ultimate journey of Self-Realization, Enlightenment, Liberation and Unification with the Divine. This is the mission of my life.

If I reflect upon my life, I am grateful for all the blessings I have received. I realize that in the beginning, it was *Karma*, the Law that was working. But I went beyond doing good Karma to becoming a *Karma Yogi*. I realized that every creature whether a human being or a beast, was nothing but a manifestation of the Divine. I experienced God as SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power in one and all and so, I served not the bodies that were suffering, but the temple that housed the Soul that was none other than the Supreme Immortal Power. This made me a *Karma Yogi*, one who is ever united with the Divine, through acts of good deeds or *Karma*.

Right from the beginning, I knew nothing is mine, that we come empty-handed and we leave empty-handed. I was blessed to live with detachment and even today, I try to give away as much as I can. I even realize that I don't give, these hands are not mine. I am just an instrument of the Divine. It is the Divine will that causes the 'giving' through my hands. It

may appear that I give, but in reality, all 'giving' is that of the Divine. If only we realize this, and we live and give, we can not only enjoy the blessings of the Supreme that will liberate us from the triple suffering on earth but ultimately, we will be united with the Divine as we are liberated from rebirth.

We may pray to a God, but we do not realize that God is not God. God is SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power, in you and me. We are ignorant about this truth and thus refrain from giving while living. Somehow, the body, mind and ego, keeps us trapped in ignorance and we do not realize that we come with nothing, and we will go with nothing. The ego makes us believe that I am 'I' and this is mine. I was lucky to realize that nothing is mine. Everything is thine! Even I am thine! With this Divine revelation, my life has evolved to where it is today. I hope that I continue to give as I live and when that day comes when it is time to go and I hear the death whistle blow, I should have given away everything that I have. My aspiration is to Give before I am Gone, so that I become one with the Divine and I am not reborn.

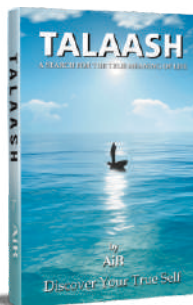

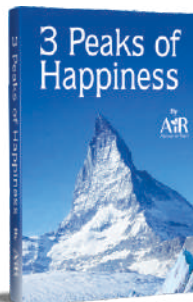
1. Talaash

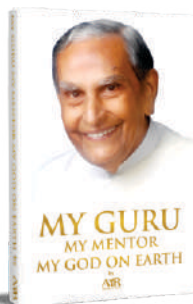
2. 3 Peaks of Happiness
